Today, at 11.00 a.m. Shri Subhash Grover, Chairman cum Managing Director administered the pledge to the Officers and staff of the Corporation in the Board Room of our Corporate Office, CBD Belapur, Navi Mumbai. Shri N. Kirubanithi, Director(Finance), Shri C.S.Teotia, Director,(Marketing) were present on this occasion. Thereafter, Messages from H.E. The President of India, Smt Pratibha Devisingh Patil , H.E.The Vice President of India, Shri M.Hamid Ansari, were read by Chief Vigilance Officer, Shri D.C.Sagar, IPS. Also the message from Central Vigilance Commission undersigned by the Central Vigilance Commissioner, Shri Pratyush Sinha, IAS, Vigilance Commissioner Shri Sudhir Kumar, IPS and Vigilance Commissioner Smt Ranjana Kumar was read in English as well as in Hindi. Keeping in mind the **Whistle Blowers' Resolution**, this year Central Vigilance Commission has given instructions for publicising the procedure of the same. **Public Interest Disclosure and Protection of Informers(PIDPI) Resolution(Whistle Blowers' Resolution)**, is one of the avenues from many avenues for prevention of corruption. Under this Resolution complaint will be received by the Central Vigilance Commission(CVC), the procedure of which is given as under:




- The complaint should sent by post.
- The complaint should be in a closed/secured envelope.
- The envelope should be addressed to Secretary, Central Vigilance Commission super scribed "Complaint under The Public Interest Disclosure".
- Name and address of the complainant should not be written on the envelope.
- Commission will not entertain anonymous/ pseudonymous complaints.

It is necessary to use the Vigilance Awareness Week to publicize the procedure for making complaints under PIDPI Resolution. It is also necessary to highlight the fact that the identity of the complainant is kept secret and the complainant is protected from victimization.

Apart from the above, Central Vigilance Commission has also given instructions for raising awareness among the people on the following points:

- Efficiency and transparency in public spending.
- Raising awareness among the Corporation's Customers, Purchasers, Farmers, and users of the different services.
- Stress should be given for the avenues available to the user citizen for redressal of grievances.
