

There is no subsidy programme executed by the CCI, hence no funds are allocated on this account. However, CCI is nominated as implementing agency of Mini Mission III & IV of Technology Mission on Cotton launched by Government of India in February 2000. Therefore, the subsidy programmes under Mini Mission III & IV on Technology Mission on Cotton, are respectively executed by way of inviting applications for constructing new market yards/improvement in existing market yards and for setting up of new Ginning & Pressing factories/modernization of existing Ginning & Pressing factories. The amount allocated in IX<sup>th</sup> & X<sup>th</sup> Plan under both the missions, amount of subsidy and details of beneficiaries are as appended below:
